#### Mídia em Destaque, de Qualidade e Valor

Featured media: 'wow' factor + very high quality (max 2 candidates under discussion)

Quality images: very high quality, well composed (max 5/day). Has to be the best quality from the camera used (not compared to best cameras!)

Valued images: the most valued illustration of its kind

Aim for encyclopaedic/educational images: Artistic is good but doesn't always help, focus on documenting what you see.

(Also Featured Media for video etc, but not working too well right now...)

If you're submitting to wiki photo competitions, going through Quality Images lets you check that you're entering the best version to the competition

# Featured has to be high quality and 'wow'



Nearly everything has to be perfect: highest quality, with a 'wow' factor, need high quality camera + timing



# O pós-processamento é importante

Quality Images process looks for high quality

#### Need to e.g.:


- Fix Chromatic Abberation
- Correct white balance
- reduce noise / sharpen
- Tweak brightness, highlights, etc.
- Vertical/horizontal alignment

etc.... Listen to feedback from reviewers + iterate + learn!

I use Lightroom, but Darktable can also do this, or Snapseed on mobile

Upload full resolution (minimum is 2 megapixel), don't upscale!
